A screening is a brief assessment using games & activities to determine a child's current level of development.

Recognizing early warning signs of childhood delays can improve a child's chances to reach their potential.



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Helping Individuals and Families with Life's Changing Needs

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Developmental Milestones:

Hearing

- Reacts when you call to him/her
- Vocalizes in a normal tone of voice
- Turns to face the source of sounds or voices by 6 months

Talking

- Says "Mama" and "Dada" by age 1
- Is talking in short sentences by age 3
- Is understood by most people outside the family by age 3

Social Skills

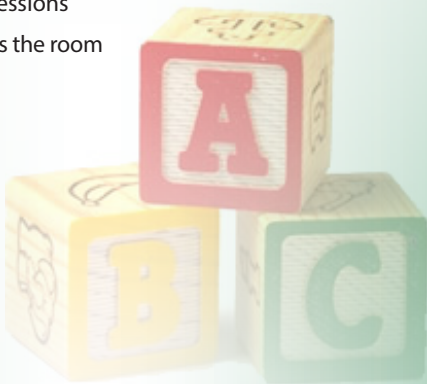
- Imitates facial expressions
- Looks at a toy across the room if you point to it
- Points at items to indicate interest

Seeing

- Follows objects with his/her eyes by age 6 months
- Views objects with both eyes aligned
- Notices objects, people, or animals around him/her when other children do

Playing

- Puts toys in his/her mouth by age 7 months
- Plays games such as peek-a-boo, patty cake, or wave bye-bye by age 1
- Imitates parents doing household chores by age 2 or 3
