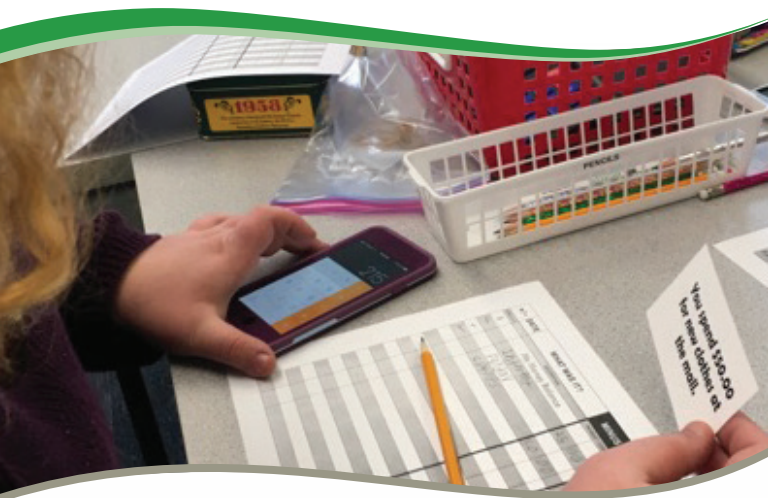


Lifesteps Pre-Employment Transition Services (P.E.T.S.)

Service Flexibility

- Training sessions provided at an educational institution or community location at no cost.
- Sessions are flexible to meet students' needs, readiness, and ability.
- Training sessions provided by a Certified Teacher. *(Session may qualify as credit)*

Eligibility

Students eligible to participate include youth and young adults ages 14-21 who:

- Have an Individualized Education Plan, or
- Meet 504 requirements of the United States Department of Education, or
- Identified as a student with a disability
